  1. Streets Councilman Carter

    - Councilman Carter would like to apply for a \$25,000 grant with the Town agreeing to pay \$2,500 as the 10% match – Council agrees to wait until Mayor Rhett has time to review proposal.

2. Recreation Council Person Pelzer
- There will be no Harvest Festival this year
  - The Nature Park will need to have the trash on the ground better maintained
3. Water and Sewer Councilman Harley
- The water department has been very diligent in addressing any water issues throughout the community in a timely fashion
  - The Town is still flushing hydrants periodically, if any resident notice any discoloration or odor please contact the office.
4. Police Department Council Person Rogers'
- Police Department filed a total of 3 incident reports during the month of July, 2021 – 1 – Assisting another agency, 1 – Suspicious Incident, 1 – EPC Vulnerable Adult
  - The Town welcome a new town deputy Mr. Everett Culpepper and we are still seeking to hire another Town Deputy
  - The Town has purchased 2 new patrol vehicles
