JANUARY 7, 2025

The Bowman Town Council met on January 7, 2025. Present were Mayor Patsy Rhett and Councilpersons, Smith, Carter and Glenn. Councilman Rogers was absent.

Department of reports was discussed starting with councilperson Smith, priorities this year she would like to see the town look into following up with the lights in the nature park along with improving the tennis court. Councilperson Glenn stated his reports for the month were all good, councilperson Carter went over the right of ways and stated if anyone has any concerns to reach out to him and he will put it in to be taking care of.

Police Chief went over the Police department reports, he also brought to the council's attention the 1033 program he discussed the cost and what the Police Department would benefit out of this program. Councilperson Carter made motion to get put on this program motion was second by councilperson Smith.

After closing remarks were made by Mayor she asked for a motion to adjourn.
