

MINUTES

TOWN OF BOWMAN/COUNCIL MEETING – 9-3-24

The Bowman Town Council meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm, by Mayor Patsy Rhett. Present were Councilperson Ada Smith who delivered the prayer, Councilman Ike Carter, who led the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilperson Deleasera Rogers. Councilman Glenn was absent.

The attendees then repeated the Civility Pledge. The chair then asked for a Motion of approval for the August meeting minutes. The finance report was made by Ms. Yvonne Lewis, see attachment. Motion was made and approved. The chair then asked for a motion to adjourn to Executive session. Motion made and approved.

Executive sessions consisted of a presentation from Councilman Carter relative to a 25,000 Tree grant from the Municipal Association for the inner-city park. After the presentation the executive sessions ended and we returned to the regular scheduled meeting.

The meeting continued with information about the \$25,000 grant. The chair then asked for a motion to approve, motion was made and approved by the voting body.

Mayor Rhett then presented information relative to the importance of the Lead line inventory that was sent to all the water customers and informed the council about the parking lot road being turned over to the Town of Bowman, it will no longer be a county road. We are awaiting the final paperwork from the DOT.

Reports from the various departments were made concerning the streets, parks, water and the police departments. The visitors were

greeted by Mayor Rhett and the council. There were two concerns from the visitors: one was the possible replacement of the clock on the wall that did not work and the other was for possible replacement of the worn flags. Mayor Rhett stated that the clock and the flags would be replaced.

The chair then asked for a motion to adjourn the September meeting, motion was made and passed and the meeting was adjourned.
